

GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is sanctioned by the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) and the Atlantic Provinces Trapshooting Association (APTA). ATA rules will govern shooting in all events.

Shoot Management insists on safe gun handling at all times. Shooters who enter the competition agree to abide by ATA and host club safety rules. Violators subject themselves to disqualification, without recourse, and may be required to leave the grounds.

Shoot Management reserves the right to reject any entry or change the program as conditions warrant. Shoot Management also reserves the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to, anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

Please be courteous to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing line, especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated.

REGISTRATION AND PRE-SQUADDING

Check daily schedules for registration times. Pre-squadding will be available through sosclays.com starting on June 1, 2025.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification Committee

Classification will be determined by current ATA target year average and known ability. Known ability will consider official shooting averages, non-registered scores and any other information determining a shooter's ability.

The Classification Committee reserves the right to review all scores in the Preliminary Day Events for classification purposes. Shooters under review may be moved to a higher class at the discretion of Classification Committee.

Penalty Classification

Shooters with less than 300 ATA registered targets per event in the current plus previous target year will be assigned a classification based on known ability and their last established ATA average and yardage. Shooters without a previously established ATA average will be classified based on known ability. Any shooter not meeting the minimum target requirements may be assigned a penalty classification

Shooters are asked to have their up to date ATA Average Card and any other target

information ready for presentation to the Classification Committee. Average Cards printed from the ATA's Shooter Information Center will be accepted.

Class Advances

Shooters winning ,or tying, for Champion or Class, in any Preliminary Day singles or doubles event, may be advanced at least one class for the next like event. Class advances are at the discretion of the Classification Committee. Handicap yardage increases will be determined based on the ATA earned yardage table.

ATA CATEGORY DECLARATION

Shooters must declare any ATA Category at the time of classification. It is the responsibility of ATA Category shooters to ensure that their category has been properly noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered.

Category shooters tied for event Champion may shoot-off for the Championship trophy. If the Category shooter fails in the Championship trophy shoot-off, they will fall back to their declared Category. A Category shooter whose score qualifies for a trophy in their declared Category, may not fall back to place or class. Where there is no Category trophy offered, the Category shooter is eligible to shoot for Class or Place trophies. Any Category shooter whose score does not qualify for a trophy in their declared Category may compete for Class or Place trophies.

TIES AND SHOOT-OFFS

Ties in all Singles and Doubles Preliminary Day Events will be determined by a carry over to the next event. Ties in any preliminary Handicap event will be determined with a shoot-off before the start of the next Handicap event.

Ties in the Championship Events will be resolved by a shoot-off and held at the discretion of the shoot committee and as time permits. Shooters not answering the shoot-off call will forfeit.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Shooters are responsible for checking their posted scores and to make sure their money options are indicated properly.

Due to the number of shooters expected, shooters are requested to be at the

shooting line promptly, and prepared to shoot when their squad is called, in order to complete all events in a timely manner.

Shoot Management also asks that squads move through events without any unnecessary delays or breaks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

TARGET SETTING / TARGETS

The Target Setting Committee will set targets each morning and for event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules and will only be reset if they vary from ATA specifications. The final decision to reset targets will be made by a member of the Target Setting Committee.

Lawry orange dome targets will be used for all events.

TROPHIES

Only shooters that <u>reside</u> in the Atlantic Provinces are eligible for the Closed (Resident) trophies. <u>All</u> shooters (regardless of residency) are eligible for the Open trophies. Please note that all Closed (Resident) trophies are awarded above Open trophies for Atlantic Province shooters.

Each option played is an entry into the daily shoot off drawing. For example: Since 2 events are offered that day and the shooter plays the option on both, they will have 2 entries into that day's drawing for the shoot off.

Shooters must select and pay for the \$10.00 option prior to the start of the event.

At the end of the day's events on Thursday and Friday, 15 qualifying participants names will be randomly drawn for that night's shoot off. You must be in attendance to participate in the shoot off. Please make sure to stick around and listen for your name to be announced. Your daily entry from playing the option that day is only good for the drawing and shoot off that day.

Shoot off participants will shoot TWO (2) targets at each post for a total of ten (10) targets Shoot off rounds will consist of ten (10) targets. Thursday's shoot off will be from the 16-yard line, Friday's shoot off will be from the shooters A.T.A. yardage (yardage as of that day). Shoot off rounds will continue until a winner is determined. Decisions made by the shoot management regarding the above listed rules, or other disputes, shall be final.


